# Airstrip bouldering

Kia ora, welcome to the Stubbs farm and the Airstrip bouldering. This climbing area is on private land and access is given by the farmer in partnership with ACAT. Please be responsible and respect all access rules and the precious environment you are entering to ensure this privilege continues.

Stubbs farm has over 800 acres of retired regenerating forest under QE2 covenant and 4 headwaters flowing through this unique limestone landscape. Respect this precious environment and only leave footprints and "chalky fingerprints".

- Please ring Ben #021421525 or Bex #0210421124 before climbing.
- Access is permitted to climbing areas, not other parts of the farm or caves.
- Please leave gates as you find them and do not block gates or tracks.
- Keep the parking and climbing area clean and tidy. Please pack out any garbage.
- Climbing access during lambing season and outside of this period is at the farmers discretion.
- Please notify the farmer if you find any animals which may need attention.
- Donations are hugely appreciated and help us continue to preserve this beautiful landscape.
